ComEd Installing Smart Meters in Deerfield

ComEd has started its installation of smart meters in the Village. ComEd officials reported that they intend to install 6,597 meters in the Village throughout this winter. Corix is the contractor that will be installing Smart Meters in Deerfield, on behalf of ComEd.

Installation typically takes 10 minutes and may cause a brief interruption to electric service. Residents will be notified by mail, phone call and door hangar of the installation. Residents are reminded that installers will carry photo identification and will never ask to enter a home or ask for money.

Smart meters are expected to reduce costs by eliminating manual meter reading costs and providing customers with real-time usage information. 30 days after deployment residents will receive a welcome card in the mail encouraging participation in new energy management tools and resources to help them save on monthly bills.
