## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

SWALCO (Solid Waste Agency of Lake County) offers free HHW collections for residents.

Mobile Collection Events are held at various locations throughout Lake County from April through November. Year-round HHW drop-off is available at SWALCO's facility in Gurnee multiple times per month - by appointment only. Schedule your appointment at [www.swalco.org](http://www.swalco.org) or call (847) 336-9340.

Waste Management will not collect solid or liquid hazardous waste. Examples include paint, pesticides; petroleum derivatives, such as motor oil and solvents, and explosive items.

## BULK ITEMS

Waste Management will collect bulk items at no additional charge. Place your bulk item at the curb on the same day as your regular trash collection. Items must be smaller than 4 ft. and weigh less than 50 lbs.



**What is a bulk item?** A bulk item is a piece of furniture or other similar residential item that's too large to fit in a container. Construction debris and hazardous waste are not considered bulk items. Waste Management asks that residents call (800) 796-9696 in advance to schedule a special pickup of construction debris, white goods or appliances.

## RESIDENTIAL ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

### GENERAL GUIDELINES

Waste Management will collect trash, recycling and yard waste once a week on your designated service day, which is **Tuesday for residents north of Deerfield Road and Wednesday for residents south of Deerfield Road.**

- Trash and recycling containers should be placed at the curb at least 5 feet from stationary objects (mailboxes, basketball hoops, vehicles, etc.).
- Carts should be placed handle toward house, along the curb.
- All containers and any solid waste materials that are not collected must be removed from the curb no later than the evening of your collection day.

### CURBSIDE TIMING

Place your carts at the curb no earlier than sundown on the day before collection or no later than 7:00 a.m. (6:30 a.m. for Deerfield and Waukegan Roads) the day of collection as there is no set route or pickup time. After collection, all carts should be removed from the front yard no later than the evening of your collection day.

### OBSERVED HOLIDAYS

Waste Management only observes the following holidays. When your collection falls on or after one of these holidays, your service will be delayed one day during that week only.

Great things happen when Deerfield residents use **Recycle Often. Recycle Right<sup>SM</sup>**. When everyday items like those shown below are recycled, tons of raw materials, time, energy and money are saved. Plus the recycled materials become new products, and the cycle continues.

- Place only the acceptable recyclables shown below together in your recycling cart - no sorting needed.
- Containers that held food should be rinsed free of food debris and liquid.
- Do not put recyclables in plastic bags - empty your recyclables loose into your cart.

### SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING SERVICE

Use your green cart with the yellow lid to place all your acceptable recyclables together. Residents living north of Deerfield Road are serviced on Tuesdays, residents living south of Deerfield road are serviced on Wednesdays. All items should be placed at the curb by 7:00 a.m. (6:30 a.m. for Deerfield and Waukegan Roads) since we cannot guarantee a specific time the driver will be at your home. Additional recycling carts may be rented from Waste Management by calling (800) 796-9696.

In 2016 the average Deerfield home set out 813 pounds of recycling or 16 pounds per week. That adds up to over 4.5 million pounds of recyclable materials diverted from the landfill by Deerfield residents. A trend in the right direction!

### TRASH SERVICE

Use the green cart with the green lid only for trash that cannot be recycled. Residents have an option to choose between a 96-gallon, 64- and 35-gallon cart. All waste must fit into the cart. Items should be placed at the curb by 7:00 a.m. (or 6:30 a.m. for Deerfield and Waukegan Roads.) since we cannot guarantee a specific time the driver will be at your home. Additional carts may be rented from Waste Management by calling (800) 796-9696.

### MISSED COLLECTION

Despite our best efforts, we occasionally miss scheduled collections. If we do, please visit [home.wm.com/Deerfield](http://home.wm.com/Deerfield) to report a missed pickup online or call (800) 796-9696. We'll try to return on the same day, without charge. If our driver has already left the Village of Deerfield we'll pick up at the missed stop the following day.

### YARD WASTE

Yard waste will be collected April 1 through December 15 in unlimited amounts. All yard waste bags/bundles must have a yard waste sticker attached in order to be collected. Bundles cannot exceed 4 feet in length or weigh over 50 lbs. Branches cannot exceed 3 inches in diameter. Stickers must be visible from the street.
