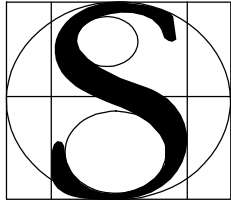

PRINKLERS

Permits ARE Required:

*For installation of a
sprinkler system
on private property.*

Permit Application and Submission Requirements:

- 2 copies of your plat of survey marked (preferably in colored ink) to show the location of all sprinkler heads.
- The permit application form filled out with the following information:
 1. Applicant's name, address and phone number.
 2. Contractor's name, address and phone number.
 3. Contractor's cost estimate of work to be done.
 4. Brief description of work to be done.

Processing Time/Fee:

- Sprinkler system permits take approximately 2 weeks to process. The fee schedule is \$23.00 per \$1,000 of the cost estimate, a \$75.00 plumbing inspection fee, plus a \$50.00 certificate of compliance fee.

Permits are NOT

Required:

*For repairs of a
sprinkler system
on private property.*

Sprinkler System Installation Requirements:

- No sprinkler heads may be located in the Village right-of-way.
- **Plumbing contractors must be licensed by the State of Illinois and be certified as an RPZ Backflow Prevention device installer.** If a copy of this license is not on file with the Community Development Department, it must be provided prior to release of the permit.
- Plumbing contractors are required by the Village of Deerfield to provide the Village with a License or Permit Bond in the amount of \$5,000 or with a state of Illinois certificate of bonding. Most local contractors have already done this. Check with the Community Development Department to make sure this bond is on file. The permit will not be released until a current bond has been provided to the Village.
