Deerfield's 2018 Winter Celebration Ushers in Holiday Season

On Friday, horse-drawn carriages will carry riders around downtown Deerfield from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. The Village Hall front lawn will feature a two-hour live ice sculpture show, roasted chestnuts and a photo booth.
