Study: Deerfield Among 15 Safest Cities in Illinois

Home security company Protection 1 released a study of Illinois communities with more than 8,000 residents and found Deerfield to be in the "15 Safest Cities in Illinois." The study examined violent and property crime statistics of each community, found in the FBI's completed 2014 Uniform Crime Reports, and compared them to the community's population. The results display how likely a violent or property crime is per 1,000 citizens.

Deerfield was listed as the twelfth safest community with 0.38 violent crimes per 1,000 residents and 7.05 property crimes per 1,000 residents.
