On February 14, 2020, Stacy A. Shapiro, 46 years old of Northbrook, Illinois, surrendered herself to authorities at the Deerfield Police Department. Shapiro turned herself in after charges were approved by the Office of the Lake County State's Attorney and a warrant was issued for her arrest relative to a crash that occurred in Deerfield on Friday, February 7th. The crash resulted in severe injury to a 12 year old resident of the Village who is still hospitalized in critical condition at Lurie Children's Hospital of Chicago.

Shapiro was charged with Leaving the Scene of an Accident Involving Personal Injury, in violation of Illinois 625 ILCS 5/11-401 (b). The charge is a Class 2 Felony punishable by 3-7 years in prison and fines not to exceed \$25,000.

Bond on the warrant was set at \$250,000 earlier in the day by a Lake County judge. Shapiro was processed and released after posting 10% of the required bond. A preliminary court date has been set for February 18, 2020 at 9:00AM in Waukegan, IL Courtroom T110.
