December 19, 2022

Last day to file nomination papers with the local election official located at Village Hall, 850 Waukegan Road, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

December 27, 2022

Last day to file objections to a candidate's nomination papers with the local election official located at Village Hall, 850 Waukegan Road, from 8:00 a.m. to noon and 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Please note, Village Hall is closed from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. each business day. Petitions will be accepted during this time the week of December 12-19.
