Electronics Recycling and Paper Shredding

The Village of Deerfield has partnered with the Solid Waste Agency of Lake County and Lakeshore Recycling Systems to bring you a series of events in celebration of Earth Day.

The following events are open to Deerfield residents only. Participants must have proof of Deerfield residency or a valid Village of Deerfield vehicle sticker to participate in the drop-off events.

Thursday, April 21

- **Electronics Recycling Event** – located at Walgreens at 1425 Lake Cook Road
 - Hours: 7 a.m. – 1 p.m.
 - Most electronics accepted. Note: old tube-style televisions, appliances, air conditioners, and fluorescent light bulbs are NOT accepted at this collection. This event is also open to Walgreens employees.

Saturday, April 23

- **Electronics Recycling Event** – located at the Deerfield Public Works Facility, 465 Elm Street
 - Hours: 9 a.m. – noon

- **Paper Shredding Event** – located in the Farmers Market parking lot (northwest corner of Deerfield Road and Robert York Avenue)
 - Hours: 10 a.m. – noon
 - Limit of 4 banker boxes per person
- **Ribbon Cutting** – Join Mayor Rosenthal, the Sustainability Commission and the Village Center Commission in the Farmers Market parking lot to unveil the new downtown recycling containers
 - Time: 10 a.m.

The new downtown recycling containers have been made possible through a partnership with the Sustainability Commission and Village Center Commission. The new containers will be serviced at no cost by Lakeshore Recycling Systems.
